



### Dear Resident of Boxgrove Parish

We hope by now you have heard of the Neighbourhood Plan for Boxgrove Parish. The Neighbourhood Plan is being drawn up by residents working with your parish councillors. We want **everyone** to have their say.





## Housing and Design

The Government says the country needs many more new homes. Chichester District Council has decided that Boxgrove Parish must take 25 more new homes between now and 2030. This is in addition to houses already approved. Our Neighbourhood Plan will take into account how many homes are needed, what type of homes are built, and where. No decisions on housing locations will be made without further consultation.


CDC has decided that only developments of six or more houses will qualify to be included against our allocation. We should still consider where smaller developments should be built and what these should comprise of.
