Survey Results Analysis



Survey Responses

- * Delivered to all 435 homes
- * 250 responses - 57.47%
- * Business survey of 29 businesses

Community Facilities

- Support for green spaces wildlife and habitats
- Value the school, shops, pub and Village Hall



Community Facilities

- Public footpaths and bridleways well supported
- Age profile shows in response to play facilities



Weaknesses

- * Pedestrian safety
- * Speed of traffic
 - * would like speed cameras and road surface changes
- * Parking
 - * would like to see more yellow lines and road surface changes
- * Dog fouling

Play Equipment

- Not considered adequate for older children
- Dog fouling
- All weather track
- Fitness trail



Teenagers

- * Not enough for teenagers to do
- * Clubs and events
- * Film nights
- * Place to hang out

Other facilities

- * Observation boards
- * Better signage
- * More litter bins
- * More permissive paths

Green and Open Spaces

- * Halnaker Mill
- * Village Green
- * Redvins Copse
- * Rear of The Priory
- * Flower meadow



Drainage

- * 31% had experienced highway flooding - Stane Street, Tinwood Lane, Crouch Cross Lane
- * 8.68% had experienced flooding at their property - surface water run-off

Housing

- * 61% agreed with 1 or 2 dwellings filling gaps inside the BUAB
- * 63.72% agreed with 3 to 9 units spread over a number of sites
- * 9.73% agreed with larger developments of over 9 units

Housing

- * 85.20% agreed with re-use of brownfield sites
- * Support for development inside the BUAB in each hamlet
- * Housing must be:
 - * energy efficient
 - * be limited to two storeys
 - * have off street parking
 - * be well designed

Housing

- * Should include:
 - * affordable homes for people from the Parish
 - * suitable homes for the needs of the elderly in the Parish

Housing

- * 17 residents looking to buy or own a two bedroomed property in the Parish
- * 25 who may require a home in the future - teenagers
- * 23 who wish to downsize to a bungalow

Working or studying

- * Mobile phone and broadband connectivity a major issue.
- * Some businesses considering relocating due to connectivity issues

Tourism

- * Support for bed and breakfast and holiday let accommodation
