As discussed when we met the other day the concept that is being proposed at present is a sensible approach – although further down the line thought will need to be given to bus services and any residents directly affected by the closure at the north end of the street.

Meantime depending on whether there is 106 money or CIL contributions or whether Boxgrove decide to increase their precept, WSCC highways will work with the Parish to see what can be achieved elsewhere in the village eg Priors Lee junction.

Unfortunately with limited finances there is no available money within WSCC and we would be looking at the above options as a way of funding any future schemes

Happy to discuss further once the Parish are in a position to move forward
